Amos 5:18-27 (NIV)

The Day of the Lord

18 Woe to you who long
for the day of the Lord!

Why do you long for the day of the Lord?

That day will be darkness, not light.

19 It will be as though a man fled from a lion
only to meet a bear,

as though he entered his house

and rested his hand on the wall

only to have a snake bite him.

20 Will not the day of the Lord be darkness,
not light— pitch-dark, without a ray of bright-
ness?

21 “I hate, I despise your religious festivals;
your assemblies are a stench to me.

22 Even though you bring me burnt offerings
and grain offerings,

I will not accept them.

Though you bring choice fellowship offerings,

I will have no regard for them.

23 Away with the noise of your songs!

I will not listen to the music of your harps.

24 But let justice roll on like a river,

righteousness like a never-failing stream!

25 “Did you bring me sacrifices and offerings
forty years in the wilderness, people of
Israel?

26 You have lifted up the shrine of your king,
the pedestal of your idols,

the star of your god[a]—

which you made for yourselves.

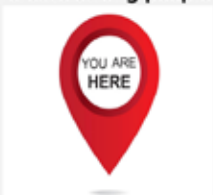
27 Therefore I will send you into exile beyond
Damascus,” says the Lord, whose name is God
Almighty.

2.) Yet there is Hope when we realize Justice is the correct moral practice in our daily personal and social lives; Righteousness then becomes the cultivation of correct moral principles.

In Hard Times, God says to His People, "Seek the LORD and live." (Amos 5:6)

3.) Our God and King wants justice & righteousness to 'roll like an ever-flowing river; like a never-failing stream that will not run dry.' (Amos 5:24)

HARD TIMES
create strong people



STRONG PEOPLE
create good times

WEAK PEOPLE
create hard times

1.) Because of Weak Leaders, Hard Times were ahead for God's People as the Corrupt Elite 'turned Justice into bitterness and cast Righteousness to the ground.' (Amos 5:7)

GOOD TIMES
create weak people
Physically, emotionally, morally, and especially *spiritually* weak people.

4.) Because we know God our King is 'watching,' He wants our day-to-day lives to be full of integrity and goodness.
